

TRANSPORTATION GRANTS

The Foundation for Geauga Parks is focused on helping Geauga County schools connect students with hands-on nature education. Research consistently shows that close experiences with nature foster deeper, more personal learning that cannot be replicated through classroom discussions or textbook images.

Gauga County schools may apply for transportation grants to help fund bus travel to naturalist-led programs at local parks. **A total of \$5,000 in grant funding will be available in 2026**, awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

ELIGIBILITY & DETAILS

- All public and private schools in Geauga County may apply.
- Grant funding may be used to pay for bus transportation to and from naturalist-led programs in Geauga County, Ohio, parks.
- The Foundation will reimburse transportation costs up to \$200 per bus.
