

SMALL GRANTS

The Foundation for Geauga Parks allocates funding each year to support its Small Grants Program. Geauga County townships, county or municipal parks, organizations, and individuals may apply for grants ranging from \$200 to \$5,000 for projects, programs, and services that align with the Foundation's mission to foster community engagement with nature.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications will be accepted for existing projects and programs or to initiate new related park projects and programs across Geauga County on a rolling basis. Check the website to see amount of funds available.

In 2026, the Foundation will fund up to \$5000 in park and trail grants and \$2500 in nature education grants.

EXAMPLE: SMALL GRANT AWARDEE

The Geauga Park District received a Small Grant for the purchase of trail markers for the Maple Highlands Trail.

The markers help trail users identify their real-time location on the trail, identify & more efficiently correct maintenance locations, and allow first responders to locate trail users quickly in case of emergency.
