

NATURE SCOPES PROGRAM FOR FIFTH GRADERS

Nature Scopes is a year-long program for Geauga County fifth graders that enhances school science instruction by providing hands-on lessons matched to the Ohio Content Standards for science education.

Nature Scopes was established in response to research showing that close encounters with nature create a direct, personal involvement with the outdoors that cannot be matched by classroom discussion or photos in textbooks.

NatureScopes is a one-of-a-kind binocular-based nature education program in which fifth-graders participate in hands-on sessions led by Geauga Park naturalists throughout the year. The program concludes with a field day where students are awarded their own binoculars and field guides (funded by the Foundation) in the hope that they will continue to explore the wonders of nature.
